



FISH-EYES

CAUSES:

- too high drying temperature
- · too short drying time between coats
- · too thick primer coat
- · unsuitable mixing and incorrect spraying technique
- · air in the paint film
- · contaminated air or machinery
- inadequate substrate preparation
- · use of unsuitable thinners

PREVENTION:

- adopt application techniques and material preparation as stated in the technical data sheet
- · check cleanliness of the machineries
- · use recommended thinners

RESTORATION:

· remove coating, clean the substrate and repaint it
